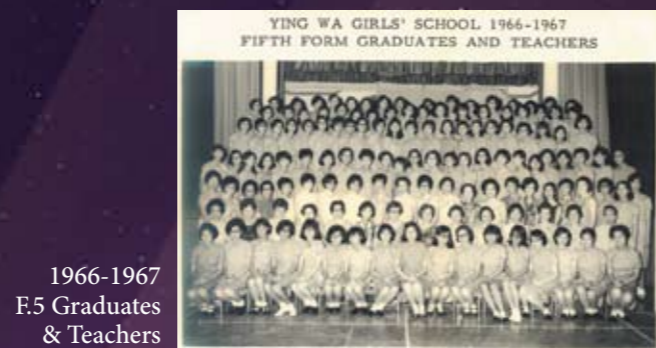

What You Do Not See in a DVD

With the successful launching of the DVD on Miss SILCOCKS in 2005, we have been looking forward to new productions by the “Capturing Ying Wa’s Heritage” Committee under the Alumnae Association Ltd.

After years of dedicated work by the committee members, a second DVD about Ying Wa finally reaches our hands this evening! Unlike the first DVD which solely focused on the life and contributions of Miss SILCOCKS to Ying Wa, the second one covers a much broader scope -- the history of Ying Wa, our school’s contribution to women education in Hong Kong, and outlook for the future.

In order to understand the background leading to the production of this DVD, the editorial team talked to Eunice WONG (Class of 1968), coordinator of the DVD production team.

“From the first DVD we have 30 hours of very rich footage we couldn’t include. The committee wanted to make good use of them in a second DVD,” said Eunice. “We are blessed to have Mabel CHEUNG Yuen Ting* directing this production. Editing the total 100 hours of footage was the greatest challenge because each personal story is unique and inspiring.”

Eunice found the whole process very fulfilling. “The meetings with Ying Wa girls helped me crystallize how the excellent tradition and culture of Ying Wa contribute to the shaping of our values, beliefs and behaviours.” she said.

Surely this heritage DVD will inspire us to follow in the footsteps of our founder and teachers in being “the salt and the light of the world”.
