On that lovely Saturday afternoon this spring, over 200 of us celebrated a milestone in our construction project. Gracing the occasion were many distinguished guests like the representatives of the EDB and the School Council, and illustrious alumnae, such as Chairlady of the School Redevelopment Steering Committee, Professor Chiu Lai Har, Rebecca, the Reverend Lee Ching Chi, former principals, Mrs Katherine Chau and Mrs Ruth Lee, and former teacher of our historic kindergarten, Dr. Luk Chiu Kwan Hung, Angela, who is today an award-winning pioneer of early childhood education in Hong Kong. They joined current and past students and teachers in witnessing this joyous moment in our school history by coming together to pray and give thanks to the Lord for His endless blessings.



After the recent appeal of our Brick Campaign went out, we were deeply touched by the generous response of many well-wishers.
