


# **Interaction with YWGS**

The YWGSAA Sponsored Walk 2023 was held on 25 Nov 2023. Despite the windy morning, 77 alumnae from Class

of 1966 to 2022, along with their families and our honorable guests,

Mr. and Mrs. Yeung, joined us for a superb walk from the Peak to the Robinson Road Campus.

From 2022, each participant would be given a specially designed metal pin of a pretty frangipani, symbolizing the memorable journey we embarked on together. The colour of the pin is different every year, hoping to give





an incentive for the alumnae to join this annual event and receive a whole collection of the pins. Ying Wa also held her Annual Sponsored Walk during Thanksgiving Week on 24 November 2023. This meaningful tradition reminds us of Ying Wa's core value of "to serve but not to be served". Our 77

alumnae raised more than \$96K, the joint efforts of AA and the school raised \$352K to be donated to 20 charitable organizations in Hong Kong under the school's patronage.


# 7. Facebook Group and Instagram

Facebook group is well-maintained to distribute official announcements, news & initiatives from both school and AA. Members are also encouraged to post their sharing and connection with

different alumnae from all over the world. Majority of the members are between the age group of 25-50. We have over 4,800 followers now.



We have also launched our Instagram since January 2020, trying to connect with current students and young alumnae. Over 1,900 followers were acquired in 4 years. Each of the posts reached >5,000 accounts on average. Content and interactions, for example polling and quiz stickers in Instagram stories, are more tailored to meet the interest of young alumnae, receiving good engagement. Alumnae also reached out via direct messages for getting quicker access to assistance needed. Majority of the followers are in the age group of 18-35, also mainly from Hong Kong, followed by the UK and Canada.

Moving forward, the social media channels will continue to serve as an open platform to provide updates and connect alumnae from all over the world.

# 8. Caring Team



The Caring Team aims to provide mutual support and strengthen bonding between alumnae and teaching staff. During the year, we maintained close contact with some overseas alumnae, former school teachers and former principals.
